*\*May be postmarked by 4/3/25 deadline if mailed registered or certified USPS mail. Be prepared to provide a copy of the receipt on 4/3/25.*

B. File your **primary filing fee\*** with your local **Treasurer or Director of Finance** between **1/2/25** and **5:00 pm 4/3/25**.  
*\*Primary Filing Fee: \$352.80*

C. File the following documents with your **Political Party House District Chair** between **noon 3/17/25** and **5:00 pm 4/3/25**.  
*\*All of these documents must be filed at the same time.*

*\*Signature Requirement: 125 signatures from qualified voters in the district you are seeking election.*
