- A. File the following documents with your local General Registrar between 1/2/25 and 5:00 pm 4/3/25.* (Find your General Registrar: <u>https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation/PublicContactLookup</u>)
 *May be postmarked by 4/3/25 deadline if mailed registered or certified USPS mail. Be prepared to provide a copy of the receipt on 4/3/25.

- B. File your **primary filing fee*** with your local **Treasurer or Director of Finance** between **1/2/25** and **5:00 pm 4/3/25**. **Contact your local Treasurer or Director of Finance for the fee amount.*
- C. File the following documents with your **Political Party Local Chair** between **noon 3/17/25** and **5:00 pm 4/3/25**.* **All of these documents must be filed at the same time.*
 - 1. Receipt for Primary Filing Fee
 - 2. Declaration of Candidacy
